### Terms and Definitions

The expression of human creativity or imagination, in any medium, that may be viewed as beautiful, evoke emotion, or inspire ideas. The term 'the arts' refers to any or all of the branches of creative activity.

<u>Art:</u>

<u>AI</u>

AI art involves artificial intelligence generated work (e.g., images or music) Art: prompted by a user and culled from creative work accessible to its algorithm. AI art can inadvertently reinforce stereotypes and unconscious bias.

#### Art Movements/Art Genres:



Art w/ a specific distinguishable style or tendency involving a philosophy or goal and with a following of people (e.g., other artists) during a distinct period of time.

Medium: The type of material an artist uses such as marble for a sculptor or brick and stone for an architect.

Composition:

The way components of an artwork are arranged in relation to each other & other people, objects, or spaces (e.g., a musical composition).

#### 1965


The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESSA) formally established art and music as part of a well-rounded K-12 education.
